Message from Pastor Johnson

Are You Whiter Than Snow?

Were you one of the millions of people who wished for a white Christmas this year? Well, whatever the color of your holiday, I trust that it was a joyous one.

Irving Berlin's "White Christmas" is one of the all-time, most popular Christmas songs. Yet for all its expression of yearning for the atmosphere of a purely ivory landscape, the words were not the desires of its composer. Even though Berlin was born in Russia and lived in New York, he headed south to Florida during his winters, as often as he could.

Snow is often joined with adjectives such as pristine and pure. Christmas is about a pristine God who sent his sinless Son to earth that we might be pure. After he grew up, a spotless Jesus said to a group who were hungry for a better way of living:

Matthew 5:8 "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.

But some of you may be saying, "Well that may be great for those perfect people out there, but not me. I have done so many bad things, I could never be pure again." But that is not true. The bible has something to say to you if you feel that way.

Psalm 51:7 Purify me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; Wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.

You see, when the purity of Jesus is applied to the repentant sinner, there is no stain that can remain. You are made completely, and eternally clean. There will be no residual shadow of that sin left in your life.

So, if you ask Jesus to wash you today, this could be the whitest winter of your life.
